We would like to emphasise that the Review is not a substitute for a CQC inspection; but specifically designed to help practices prepare for certain aspects of the CQC GP Practice Inspections. Door Entry Codes

GPC has recently reminded Practices that confidential door entry codes must be recorded correctly in patient electronic records, as they may be uploaded to the Patient Demographic Service. Enter the information using Read Code 915L and free text the code.

CHILD PROTECTION PLANS AND SECONDARY CARE

A reminder that if you are aware, or become aware, that a patient of yours is subject to a Child Protection Plan and is attending a Secondary or Community Care Provider, either locally or (especially) outside Derby and Derbyshire, it is good practice to ensure that the provider is aware of the existence of the Child Protection Plan.

GOOD MEDICAL PRACTICE

Following a recent incident, I remind you that if you accept a Police Caution, are charged with an offence, or convicted, you must notify the GMC as soon as possible. This includes offences that have nothing to do with your medical practice, eg. Road traffic offences. I remind you that ignorance of the contents of "Good Medical Practice" is no defence against a Fitness to Practice allegation. I strongly urge all doctors to ensure that they are fully aware of the contents of "Good Medical Practice" and its associated documentation. All doctors should have a printed copy of "Good Medical Practice" which will have been sent to them by the GMC and the document is available at the GMC website www.gmc-uk.org.

MEDICAL ASSESSMENTS FOR EMPLOYMENT AND SUPPORT ALLOWANCE (ESA)

Millions of patients nationally are being called for medical assessments by ATOS Healthcare to see whether they are entitled to transfer from Incapacity Benefit to ESA. The letters that these patients receive summoning them to their medical assessment states "if you have any medical reports that you wish to use please also bring them with you. For example, this could be a medical report from your doctor ...". This does not mean that a patient MUST bring a medical report with them. They may request a report from their GP and it is the Practices decision whether to do such a report and, if so, whether and how much to charge for it.

We have put a template letter on our website for Practices to give to patients explaining the situation if they do not wish to undertake such reports.
