

# DE MONTFORT UNIVERSITY PRACTICE NURSING PROGRAMME

The Programme aims to prepare registered nurses who have not worked in general practice before to have a baseline competence in the General Practice Nursing (GPN) role through both theoretical and practice learning. This will allow employers in the future to expect a safe, competence practice nurse and a certain level of consistency in terms of knowledge, skills and competence.

This programme incorporates academic learning and work based learning and includes key clinical skills required for General Practice Nursing which includes venepuncture, ear care, wound management, Immunisations and cervical cytology and much more.

There are two Intakes per year, September and January and the course takes 9 months to complete.
