## PRODUCT LICENCE RESTRICTIONS TO OTC SUPPLY BY COMMUNITY PHARMACISTS

Community Pharmacists support patient to self-care. However, some OTC medicines have restrictions in their product licences. This is a list of the most common restrictions/age limits. Requests for unlicensed indications and patients will be refused by the community pharmacy.
