

Driving instructions


- Car share / walk: If possible, please car share with colleagues attending or walk to the venue on the day.

Walking directions from Derby Arena to the Riverside Centre:

As soon as you walk out of Derby Arena, turn right and keep walking, go straight across at the roundabout and turn into Riverside Court (see image below).
